# Current Trends and Existing Conditions:

**Mobilehome Parks** 

#### What is a mobilehome park?

- Mobilehome park = any area of land or property in California that has two of the following that are held out for rent or lease:
  - Mobilehomes
  - Manufactured homes
  - Recreational vehicles
  - Lots



#### What is a special occupancy park?

 Special occupancy park = any area of land or property in California with at least two of the following that are held out for rent or lease:


- Recreational vehicles
- Tents
- Camping cabins
- Camp Cars
- Camping Party
- Lots



#### **Regulatory Updates Since 2019**

- Mobilehome Residency Law Protection Program (AB 318, Chapter 736, Statute 2023)
  - In effect until January 1, 2027
  - Helps resolve certain disputes between mobilehome/manufactured homeowners in mobilehome parks and park owners/managers.
  - Staff processes complaints and coordinates assistance to help resolve the most severe alleged violations received.
- Mobilehome Park Permit to Operate Penalty Fee Waiver (Title 25, amended sections 1002, 1009, 2002, and 2009)
  - For park owners/operators experiencing financial hardship from winter storms of 2023/2024, or other declared states of emergency.
  - Only Permit to Operate <u>Penalty</u> fees are eligible; not annual Permit to Operate fees.

#### Statewide Mobilehome Lots by Region



| <u>Mobilehome</u> | <b>Parks</b> |
|-------------------|--------------|
| 2019              | 5,308        |
| 2024              | 5,230        |
