## **Phase II Public Comment Summary and Responses**

As noted in Attachment D “Citizen Participation and Consultation Summary,” the public has had four formal opportunities, in addition to stakeholder meetings, to comment on California’s Phase II Application to the National Disaster Resilience Competition (NDRC). In addition, throughout the entire NDRC application process, the public has had the opportunity to submit comments, questions, and suggested projects through the State’s NDRC email address (CA-NDRC@hcd.ca.gov). The public and all stakeholders were invited to comment on the public review draft of the State’s Phase II Application between October 9, 2015, and 5:00 p.m. October 23, 2015, however the Public Comment Tool and the email address were open until 5:00pm on October 24<sup>th</sup> in the event some late comments arrived.

Two public hearings were held in Tuolumne County, one on October 13, 2015 in Groveland, and the other October 14, 2015 in Sonora, where the public was invited to submit comments on all elements of the application and have open discussion on each of the proposed activities in the application. The hearing agendas included open dialogue sessions that were informative and productive. Hearing attendees were clearly more interested in having questions answered during the open dialogue than submitting formal comments. In addition, UC Merced hosted a regional meeting on campus on October 14, 2015. A public meeting was held in Sacramento on October 16, 2015 that also included a webcast available to all interested parties across the State. The State prepared a 4 page briefing document and informed participants about the Public Comment Tool on the State’s NDRC website and e-mail address to send written comments electronically. Throughout the preparation of the NDRC application, the State provided a Project

Submission Form and an email address for comments ([CA-NDRC@hcd.ca.gov](mailto:CA-NDRC@hcd.ca.gov)). Written comments were also accepted through the mail during the comment period.

### **Comment Topics and Responses**

***Overall Benefit*** – A comment was received that the benefits discussion could be expanded to include more of the benefits to forest, environment, watershed, air quality, and communities. And includes intangibles such as health, access to natural landscapes, and availability of a high quality water supply.

***Response:*** The NDRC Team appreciates this comment and has taken it under advisement while finalizing the Phase II Application. Further, it is important to note, the Overall Benefit section of the Application relates to an overall benefit requirement of CDBG funding (the basis of these potential grant funds) that at least 50% of the funding awarded be spent on low- and moderate-income (LMI) beneficiaries. HUD’s definition of LMI is anyone whose income is at or below 80% of area median income for the county (AMI),

adjusted for family size. Those limits for 2015 can be found at this link: [HCD HOME and CDBG Income Limits](#)

***Post-Disaster Threats, Hazards, and Vulnerabilities*** - A comment recommended that the NDRC team elaborate on the benefits of the three-part project to the local economy and provide specific examples as to how the elements of the application would increase the community's capacity for resilience and adaptation through the methods described therein.

***Response:*** The NDRC Team appreciates this comment and has taken it under advisement while finalizing the Phase II Application.

***Describe How Proposal is a Model*** – A comment suggested that this section could be strengthened by providing an example of how a similarly situated community could use the same 3 key components to improve resiliency and recover from fire disaster. More specifically, the NDRC team could cite the recent Valley and Butte fires as example communities, and expand the discussion of the tree mortality/bark beetle issue. And explain that the combination of the three proposed components could be useful not only for fire resilience and fire disaster, but also to aid overcoming other types of natural disasters.

***Response:*** The NDRC Team appreciates this comment and has taken it under advisement while finalizing the Phase II Application.

***Forest and Watershed Health:*** Comments were received regarding the component on forest and watershed health. One comment suggested that that reducing fuel load and making the watershed more fire safe is the most important effort and should receive a greater share of the funding. Another comment recommended the section on Forest and Watershed Health should discuss the engagement of private, state, and federal landowners/partners. Since forest management as discussed by the application will require fuels thinning, reforestation, and watershed restoration on lands owned and managed by private timber operators, small landowners, United States Forest Service, and possibly other state and federal entities, it is important to acknowledge the awareness of these complexities and outline solutions for addressing them and any regulatory or cost barriers to completing the work as envisioned by the application.

***Response:*** The NDRC Team appreciates these comments and will take them under advisement while finalizing the Phase II Application. The project partners include the US Forest Service, CAL FIRE, the local tribe, local government, and representatives of local landowners and all are committed to working together to implement the program.

***Biomass and Wood Products Facility*** – One comment asked for more specifics on whether the biomass facility will be connected to the grid or if it is planned as a stand-alone facility, and what the basic breakdown is of the power. The comment also recommended including an explanation of the role of transportation in the relatively high cost of biomass energy and how siting the biomass power facility near the feedstock you much reduce this cost.

**Response:** The NDRC Team appreciates these recommendations and others from the Rural Counties Representatives of California and look forward to working with them on evaluating this program and replicating it in other parts of rural California. Since the siting of the biomass facility has not been determined, all of the options listed by the commenter are on the table and will be discussed as development begins if awarded.

**Community Resilience Centers:** One comment questioned the inclusion of community resilience centers in the proposal expressing a preference for focusing on fuel load management only. Another comment made specific suggestions about the use of the centers for hosting homebuyer assistance programs and assistance with rebuilding after a disaster. In addition, the centers' use as a job-training center could be focused on forest and watershed health.

**Response:** The NDRC team developed the three pillars of the program in consultation with a broad range of stakeholders and the proposal reflects the ideas with the most support that build resilience and meet the program criteria. The community resilience centers will be designed after additional community charettes, so there is an opportunity to consider additional uses of the centers.

**HUD Natural Disaster Resilience Competition Mechanics** – Several comments asked specific questions about the HUD NDRC process including: How traditional transportation and water projects compete for funding under NDRC; HUD's timeframe for decision-making; and multiple suggestions from one resident for improving the written application.

**Response:** The NDRC team addressed with stakeholders the parameters of the Natural Disaster Resilience Competition including the allowable categories of expenditure, which largely exclude traditional transportation and water projects due to Rim Fire tie-back concerns, and telecommunication improvements which are expressly prohibited under the NDRC Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA). This was detailed in numerous presentations in meetings. HUD’s general timeline for decision-making was outlined during the statewide webinar and has been posted on the NDRC webpage throughout the proposal development process. The suggestions for improving the readability of the application were graciously accepted.

**Recreation** – One comment related to the Conceptual Trial Plan for the Groveland Trail Heads advocacy group. While the area mountain bike trails are not part of the final proposal, the group hopes they can continue to work with the County and others to identify other funds to build the trails.

**Response:** The NDRC team will be inclusive in the continued planning and implementation of the program and anticipate ancillary benefits and opportunities to other community objectives. If there is an opportunity to incorporate some of the fire break work with the needs of the mountain bike community, the Team will facilitate those discussions.

**Partnerships** – One comment addressed concerns about the qualifications of one community group as a partner.

**Response:** The NDRC team appreciates the input and has taken it into advisement.
