Dear Mr. Velasquez:

The Department is pleased to advise you that it is approving the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development’s Public Action Plan (PAP) for Community Development Block Grant disaster recovery (CDBG-DR) funds appropriated by the Disaster Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022 Public Law 117-43. On October 29, 2021, the Department allocated \$231,203,000 to the State of California for the purpose of assisting in long-term recovery from major disasters that occurred in 2020.

Consistent with the February 3, 2022, *Federal Register* notice, the State of California submitted the CDBG-DR PAP to HUD on June 8, 2022, which includes activities to assist in long-term recovery from major disasters. Subsequently, at the Department’s request, the State of California submitted revisions on July 31, 2022, which addressed all requirements for approval. The approved PAP must be made available to the public via the grantee’s website. Posting the PAP gives the public and other key stakeholders the opportunity to review the PAP.

The PAP proposes projects and programs that meet the requirements of the *Federal Register* notice. The list of CDBG-DR funded programs and respective budgets are in the CDBG-DR Disaster Allocation Table below.
