STATEMENT OF FACTS - SMOKE DETECTOR

SECTION I. INSTRUCTIONS

The California Health and Safety Code (HSC) requires that on the date of transfer of title all used manufactured homes, mobilehomes, and multifamily manufactured homes be equipped with an operable smoke detector installed in each room designed for sleeping. A declaration may be signed within 45 days prior to the date of sale stating that this requirement has been met.

Upon transfer of title, Sections II, III and IV of this form must be completed and submitted to the Department of Housing and Community Development along with the appropriate titling documents. This certification must be provided to the Department of Housing and Community Development each time title to the manufactured home or mobilehome is transferred as a result of a sale.
