SUBJECT: Voucher Numbers—Enterprise Zone Allocations

The Department of Housing and Community Development (Department) has developed the numbering system that enterprise zones should use to individually identify all vouchers issued for the hiring tax credit. Enterprise Zones should implement this system as of January 1, 2008. The following sections provide an overview of the system.

Requirement for Voucher Numbers

Section 8463(b) of the California Code of Regulations, Title 25, requires enterprise zones to sequentially identify vouchers issued using numbers allocated by the Department. To implement this requirement, the Department has developed a numbering system that allocates specific ranges to each enterprise zone. See Attachment A for a list of the designated ranges.

To adhere to the requirement for a voucher number, an enterprise zone should assign a number from its designated range to each voucher issued as of January 1, 2008. The vouchering agent should place the assigned number in the box located in the upper right-hand corner of the recently-issued Voucher Certificate.

Allocations Made to All Enterprise Zones

The requirement for a number applies to vouchers issued by all of the enterprise zones. Because the regulations allow expired and some conditional zones, as well as existing zones, to issue vouchers, we have allocated separate numbers to each of these zones. As a result, jurisdictions that have both an expired and a newly-designated enterprise zone will need to distinguish the vouchers issued by these zones. For example, if a single vouchering agent processes applications for both the previous and new zone, the agent cannot use the numbering sequence for the newly-designated zone to number a voucher attributable to the expired zone, and vice versa. In this

example, the vouchering agent will need to ensure that the jurisdictions use the numbering range assigned to the enterprise zone to which the vouchers correspond.

Enterprise Zones May Allocate Ranges to Jurisdictions

The range of numbers allocated to the enterprise zones permits them to number up to 9,999 vouchers. If an enterprise zone has more than one jurisdiction and vouchering agent, it may assign part of its range to the other jurisdictions. For example, Enterprise Zone ABC may assign Jurisdiction A the range of ABC-08-0001 to ABC-08-2999, Jurisdiction B the range of ABC-08-3000 to ABC-08-5999, and Jurisdiction C the range of ABC-08-6000 to ABC-08-9999. Each of the jurisdictions would use its respective range to number the vouchers it issued. In this way, Jurisdictions A, B, and C will observe the requirement and designated range, but may continue to separately process vouchers issued through the enterprise zone.

Exception: The Department will permit the enterprise zones administered by the Cities of Los Angeles and San Jose to use one set of numbers for their respective zones to accommodate their data processing systems. However, each of these zones must maintain the alphanumeric code assigned to them (e.g., XLAC-08, LAES-08, etc.).

Requests for More Allocations

Enterprise zones should use the numbering sequence described in Attachment A for any vouchers issued in 2008. The Department will issue a new sequence each calendar year. If an enterprise zone exhausts its allocated range before the end of the calendar year, it should contact the Department for a new allocation.

Report on Voucher Activity

The requirement for a number will apply to each voucher issued by the enterprise zone. Although the enterprise zone is not required to assign a number to the applications it denies, it should maintain a record of these applications so that the Department can track and monitor the number of applications accepted (as opposed to approved) by the enterprise zone. To record this activity, the Department recommends that enterprise zones establish a log or table that identifies key dates and results for each application. This information should include the date the enterprise zone received the application and specific distinguishing characteristics, such as the business and employee name. See Attachment B for the suggested format.

At the end of the calendar year, the Department will request from each enterprise zone a breakdown of the number of applications approved, denied, and pending. If requested by the Department, the enterprise zones may need to provide information on the total vouchers issued by voucher number.

Instruction for Active Zones: Each enterprise zone should use its corresponding numbering sequence listed below for each voucher it issues from January 1, 2008, through December 31, 2008. Enterprise Zones that consist of more than one jurisdiction and more than one vouchering agent may divide their allotment of voucher numbers among their respective jurisdictions. For example, an enterprise zone with two vouchering agents can allot the sequence 08-0001 to 08-4999 to the first agent and 08-5000 to 08-9999 to the second agent.
