Proposition 1C authorized \$850 million for infill area infrastructure improvements and brownfield cleanup. The current state budget includes an appropriation of \$240 million for this purpose under the Infill Incentive Grant Program.

As previously announced, and as part of the process for developing guidelines for this new program, the Department of Housing and Community Development is conducting a series of stakeholder meetings. The purpose of these meetings will be to share HCD's very preliminary thoughts on the program, and to solicit input from local government, developers, and other interested parties on how it should be designed.
