



## HUD Announces New Income Limits Affecting OOR

The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) recently announced new income limits effective June 15, 2022, that may affect some applicants to the ReCoverCA Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program (OOR). Homeowners who submitted their [Housing Needs Assistance Surveys](#) before June 15, will not be affected by the change.



Surveys submitted after HUD income limits go into effect will have their tier based on the updated information. Existing surveys without an income certification will also certify using updated income limits. Existing survey respondents who failed income certification under

previous HUD income limits will remain ineligible.

The OOR Program is federally funded and HUD guidelines dictate that 70% of funds go to low-to-moderate income homeowners. Survey respondents are placed into a “tier” based on income, location, and severity of need. Applications are open to Tier 1 first, followed by subsequent tiers.

## ReCoverCA Disaster Housing Assistance Survey for 2017 and 2018 Survivors Set to Close July 30

HCD will close the Disaster Housing Assistance Survey for homeowners affected by 2017 and 2018 disasters on July 30, 2022. The survey, the first step for survivors interested in the ReCoverCA OOR Program, originally opened in Fall of 2020.

ReCoverCA encourages all homeowners of single-family or manufactured housing units who are still rebuilding from 2017 or 2018 disasters to complete the survey at <https://recover.hcd.ca.gov/>. Survey instructions, program overview information, and eligibility criteria can all be found on the ReCoverCA website.

Survey respondents submitting after July 30 will not be eligible for 2017 or 2018 OOR funds.
