

To Affordable Housing developers, NGOs, and affiliated organizations in Butte, Lake, Los Angeles, Shasta and Ventura counties:

This California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) will release the 2018 Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Action Plan for public comment on July 8, 2020.

This Action Plan outlines how the state proposes to program the \$1,017,399,000 of CDBG-DR funds, allocated by HUD as a result of the federally declared disasters that began in July and November, 2018:

- FEMA DR-4382 July 23 September 19, 2018 wildfires and high winds: River, Ranch (Mendocino Complex), and Carr Fires.
- FEMA DR-4407 November 8 November 25, 2018 wildfires: Camp, Woolsey Fires.

The Action Plan being released outlines single-family, multi-family (including small-rental), and workforce development programs. These include specific program and jurisdictional allocations and methods of distribution.

HCD is hosting a virtual meeting for the affordable housing development community (developers, property managers, supportive service providers, etc.). This targeted session allows for discussion of programmatic, regulatory and compliance requirements that are of interest to the affordable housing development community.
