

### Reminder: ReCoverCA OOR Application Remains Open

The application for 2017 and 2018 HCD ReCoverCA OOR grants remains open. If you are the owner of a single-family home or manufactured housing unit damaged in an eligible 2017 or 2018 disaster, please visit the website at [www.hcd.ca.gov/recoverca](http://www.hcd.ca.gov/recoverca) for more information. The Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program (OOR) is funding that helps complete rehab or reconstruction that remains after insurance, settlements, FEMA, and other programs have paid out. HCD hopes the extended timeline will allow more homeowners to get assistance rebuilding.

Eligible owners who have completed a ReCoverCA Housing Needs Assistance survey will be invited to complete the application through a case manager. If a case manager contacted you and you have not yet completed your OOR application, please contact [your case manager](#) as soon as possible. ### OOR Home Construction Continues

Construction continues on numerous homes that were damaged or destroyed in 2017 or 2018 disasters in communities throughout California. In addition to stick-built homes, dozens of mobile homes are expected to be installed in the near future.

Construction is taking place at a rapid pace. In one case, a Butte County family's home was completed in just 66 days from groundbreaking to certificate of occupancy. "Family and friends were astonished," said the homeowner.
