Webinar Goal

Help applicants feel more confident filling out the AHSC Benefits Calculator Tool



Purpose of Quantification

- Estimate and communicate climate and other benefits such as reductions in vehicle miles travelled, greenhouse gas emissions, and criteria pollutants.
- Evaluate program performance
- Facilitate comparison of projects in competitive scoring



Quantification Approach

- Apply at the project level
- Provide uniform methods to be applied statewide and be accessible by all applicants
- Use existing and proven tools and methods, where available and appropriate
- Use project-level data, where available and appropriate
- Result in GHG emission reduction estimates that are conservative and supported by empirical literature





Quantification Approach Continued

- Benefits Calculator Tool translates the Quantification Methodology (QM) into an Excel-based tool






Round 7 Major Updates

- Quantify emission reductions of Shared Mobility Projects








Quantification Tips

- Have the QM and User Guide handy.
- Review inputs for all quantifiable components to determine which components you want to/can quantify.
- Documentation is required for all user inputs. Specific requirements for each Benefits Calculator Tool tab are listed in the AHSC application workbook.
- Ensure inputs in Benefits Calculator Tool match the inputs in documentation.
