***THESE HHAP 7 ALLOCATIONS ARE PRELIMINARY AND NOT FINAL.** These preliminary allocations have been calculated based on the statutory formula required in HSC 50241(a), using 2025 Point-In-Time (PIT) count data, and with unexpended HHAP 1 funds reallocated among eligible applicants pursuant to HSC 50239(i). HCD is releasing these preliminary allocations as a planning tool for regions to begin drafting HHAP 7 budget plans. Final allocations will include reallocations of unexpended HHAP 2 and 3 funds, and will be available in September 2026.

*When more than one eligible Large City is within the same CoC PIT count area, the proportionate share of funds shall be equally allocated to those Large Cities per HSC 50241(a)(1)(B).

**No more than 45 percent of the total allocation for Large Cities can be allocated to an individual Large City, the excess is redistributed to all other Large Cities proportionately per HSC 50241(a)(1)(B).

***No more than 40 percent of the total allocation for Counties can be allocated to an individual County, the excess is redistributed to all other Counties proportionately per HSC 50241(a)(1)(C).
