The State of California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has posted proposed changes to the 2020/2021 CDBG-DR Substantial Action Plan Amendment (APA 5) allocation for areas impacted by 2020 Wildfires (FEMA DR-4558 and DR-4569) and 2021 Wildfires (FEMA DR-4610).
