Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR)

Tribal Entities webinar on October 30, 2025

As a result of the 2021 wildfires ([DR-4610](#)), the State of California received \$24,408,000 million of CDBG-DR funds to address disaster impacts and mitigate future disasters. The CDBG-DR funding must be spent in Plumas County. Representatives from the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) will discuss the proposed CDBG-DR housing and mitigation programs, and the budget and funding timeline in the following public meeting webinars:

The [draft 2023 APA 2 CDBG-DR Action Plan](#) is available for public review and comment on HCD's CDBG-DR website through November 10, 2025. The Action Plan outlines how HCD plans to allocate these additional funds. The public will be able to comment on the draft action plan during the required 30-day public review period from October 10, 2025, through November 10, 2025.
