PUBLIC WEBINAR MEETING NOTICE

Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR)

As a result of the January 2023 winter storms, flooding, landslides, and mudslides (FEMA DR-4683) the State of California received an additional \$85,349,000 of CDBG-DR funds to address disaster impacts and mitigate future disasters to the existing \$115,022,000, bringing the total allocation for this disaster to \$200,371,000. The CDBG-DR funding must be spent within areas impacted by the disaster, including Merced, Santa Cruz, San Luis Obispo, San Joaquin, and Ventura Counties. HCD will discuss the proposed CDBG-DR housing and mitigation programs, and the budget and funding timeline in the following public meeting webinars:
