If your home was damaged by the February–July 2023 or January 2024 severe storms, you may qualify for assistance through the ReCoverCA Single-Family Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program.

Funding is limited. Apply early to get started.



HOW TO APPLY

STEP 1: Create an account and start your application.

STEP 2: Upload supporting documents.

STEP 3: Submit your application.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED



Proof of identity (such as a driver's license or passport)



Proof that you lived in the home at the time of the disaster (such as a utility bill, bank statement, or insurance policy)



Income information (such as tax returns or pay stubs)



Documents showing damage to your home (such as insurance documents, FEMA/SBA letters, or County records)

Download a paper application via the website or request one by phone, email, or mail.

Missing a document?

Program staff may be able to help identify alternative documentation.

3 See if your household income is within the limit.

Income from all adult household members (18+) must be included.
