The application for 2017 and 2018 HCD ReCoverCA Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program grants will remain open beyond December 1, 2022. Owners of single-family homes or manufactured housing units who are interested in ReCoverCA OOR grants will have more time to complete their applications and participate in the program.

Eligible owners who have completed a ReCoverCA Housing Needs Assistance survey will be invited to complete the application through a case manager. Construction is currently in progress on more than 20 homes that were damaged or destroyed in 2017 or 2018 disasters throughout California. The ReCoverCA Owner-Occupied Housing Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program (OOR) is funding that helps complete rehab or reconstruction that remains after insurance, settlements, FEMA, and other programs have paid out.

While rebuilding has been a long process for so many homeowners affected by disasters, HCD is happy to help households move back in who otherwise may not have been able to.
