



Which ReCoverCA Pathway Is Right for You?

Explore the recovery options below to see how ReCoverCA may be able to help.

If your home was damaged by the severe storms that occurred between February and July 2023 or in January 2024, **ReCoverCA** may be able to help. Depending on your home's condition and program requirements, you may qualify for one of the recovery options below.

Is Your Home in an Eligible Area?

Your home must be located in one of the following eligible areas:

**Monterey • San Benito • Santa Cruz • Tulare •
Tuolumne • San Diego Counties
Hoopa Valley Indian Reservation**

Pathway	If this sounds like you...	How ReCoverCA May Help
 Repair	My home needs to be repaired.	Repair eligible disaster damage and restore your home to a safe, livable condition.
 Rebuild	My home was severely damaged.	Rebuild your home. Homes in certain flood-risk areas may also be elevated.
 Replace	My manufactured or mobile home was damaged.	Replace an eligible manufactured or mobile home.
 Reimbursement	I already paid to repair or rebuild my home.	Pay you back for eligible repair or rebuilding costs you've already paid, based on ReCoverCA's cost estimates.*

**Reimbursement amounts are based on ReCoverCA's cost estimates and may be different from the amount you paid. Eligibility and program requirements apply.*



Single-Family Rehabilitation and Reconstruction Program

How is my recovery option determined?



After you apply, ReCoverCA will review your application and inspect your property to determine your recovery option is right for your situation. Your home must have at least \$8,000 in eligible disaster-related damage to qualify. Other eligibility and program requirements apply.

Who can apply?



Homeowners

- Owned and occupied your home when the disaster occurred
- Still own the home
- Use it as your primary residence
- Meet income and other program requirements
- Have eligible disaster-related damage



Landlords

- Owned the rental property when the disaster occurred
- Have eligible disaster-related damage
- Meet program requirements
- Agree to rent the home to income-qualified households for the required affordability period

Additional Help

Relocation Assistance

If you must temporarily leave your home because of ReCoverCA-funded repairs or rebuilding, you may be eligible for relocation assistance while the work is underway.

Flood Insurance Assistance

Eligible households with homes in certain high-risk flood areas may receive help paying for flood insurance for two years.
