

The RHNA Subregion Process

This is the statutory language that allows the formation of subregions within COGs. A subregion is then responsible for creating a RHNA allocation plan for its respective jurisdictions.

Government Code Section 65584.03:

“...at least two or more cities and a county, or counties, may form a subregional entity for the purpose of allocation of the subregion's existing and projected need for housing among its members in accordance with the allocation methodology established pursuant to Section 65584.04. The purpose of establishing a subregion shall be to recognize the community of interest and mutual challenges and opportunities for providing housing within a subregion.”

Subregions in the 6th Cycle:

Solano County (ABAG region) was the only subregion formed in the 6th cycle.
